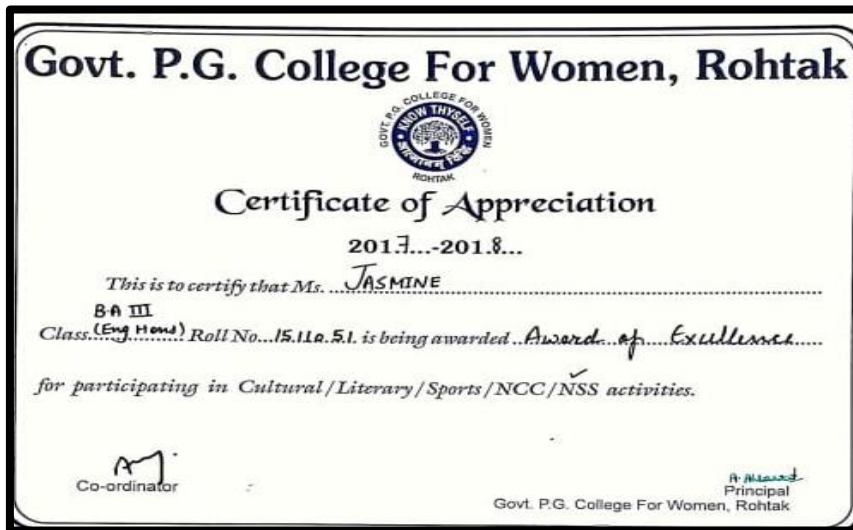



The Government/Recognized Institute shall apply the reference in the award letter regarding maintenance of A/c, expenditure, registration etc. of the awardee as per the award letter. Based on the award date received from the concerned Government/Recognized Institute, the payment of the following will be made to the awardee:-

1. Salary and gratuity (if any) for the period of 10th 'MARCH' with bank account of awardee as per the award letter and transfer and effective statement of indebtedness for bank account of the awardee. As per award, Secretary, UGC has already requested the awardee to keep account in college maintained with bank till the 31st MARCH 2019 and to be closed.
2. Award money for award for the period as specified by Implementing/Managing agency and it will also cover legal action against the Institute in the following cases:

  - (vi) Termination of JRF.




