Report of Mentor-Mentee Groups (Arts)

Total strength of students in Arts Stream in the session 2020-2021 was around 12752. Two groups Mentor-Mentee and Tutorials were formed. Number of students in Mentor-Mentee group was 973 and in Tutorial group was 1779 (approx.).

Report of Mentor-Mentee Groups (Science)
