Admission Process:-

The admission process for the current session was online and was strictly based on merit. The total strength of the college was 6422.

Academic Excellence:-

The college feels proud on its students for excelling in the university examination in spite of the challenges of Covid Pandemic. Even the results of different courses run in the college have been much higher than the university pass percentage.

IQAC:-

A Webinar on New Education Policy was organized on 25.02.2021 and A National Webinar on PCOD was organized on 18.01.2021 by IQAC. It was followed by Science Exhibition on 20.1.2021 in which Science Society presented latest models and experiments. "Martial Arts Camp" was organized from 27th January to 2nd February 2021 to make the students strong and self dependant. Clean and Green drive was started on the campus and tree plantation was done by students as well as staff. A webinar on winning the Battle against Breast Cancer was organized in collaboration with Medanta Hospital Gurugram on 17th April 2021. Various activities were organized to celebrate "Azadi Ka Amrit Mahotsava".

Departments / Committees / Cells / Clubs/ NCC/ NSS Units: Agenda & Deployment:-

Science Day was celebrated on 28.2.2021 by organizing online Science Quiz Contest, Poster making completion, let's plant a plant event. All the departments organized inter class competitions.

Assignments were regularly given and internal assessment was done continuously by all departments. Seminars were organized within the classes to boost the confidence of the students. Online Classes were regularly taken and syllabus was completed well in time and PDFs, video lectures, YouTube lectures etc. were also provided to the students.

Placement cell:-

Keeping in mind the vision of the college “to empower their students”, the Placement Cell has put its best in providing the platform for students to leash out their talents by availing placement opportunities. Students were motivated to attend Webinar on “How to be job ready for post Covid-19 opportunities” by GVM ITM on 07.01.2020 and students actively participated in Infosys Placement Drive by GRD Roper Chandigarh on 14.12.2021.

NSS:-

Our four NSS Units worked efficiently throughout the session. Two volunteers of Unit III and IV were sent to MDU Trial Camp for Pre Republic-day selections on 11.11.2020 and five volunteers got themselves registered on 9.2.2021 For Old age and Orphan Home Care. All the units attended IGOT (Integrated Govt. Online Training) on 4.1.2021 at Diksha Platform. One week Road Safety Workshop from 11th -16th January 2021 was organised to spread information regarding to road safety. All the four units organized seven days camp from 15th to 21st January 2021.

YouthRed Cross:-

Youth Red Cross worked relentlessly throughout the session by organizing various competitions and by spreading awareness for health and hygiene. Tree plantation programme was organized on 15.8.2020 to make the campus lush green. Poster making and slogan writing Competitions were organized on the occasion of Good Governance day on 25.12.2020 Inter College Essay Writing Competition on 15.7.2021 was organized to celebrate World Population Day and again on 12.1.2021 National Youth Day. Online Extension lecture on Female Hygiene on 10.2.2021 was organized to spread awareness for female hygiene. Blood Donation Camp was also organized in the college campus on 08.03.2021 in which 150 Female volunteers donated blood. Nurse Day and Yoga Day were celebrated in virtual mode on 21.05.2021 and 21.6.2021.

Earn While You Learn Scheme:-

Under this scheme 39 students of economically weaker sections were given chance to earn during their vacant period by working in different departments/library and Rs. 80,000 were disbursed among them.

Women cell:-

Being a girl’s college, we lay special emphasis on the safety and security of the female students. Seven days Self Defense “Martial Arts Training” was organized from 27th January to 2nd February 2021 to make the girls physically strong and confident and Seven Days Yoga camp was also organized for all round development of the female students.

Legal Literacy Cell:-

Legal Literacy cell organizes activities throughout the session to spread legal awareness among the students but due to pandemic only a few activities could be organized. Extension lecture on Women Laws was organized to spread knowledge of laws which are helpful for females.

Sports Committee:-

Following all Covid Protocols Physical Education Department of the college organized Yoga Competition on 21.02.2021, Kabbadi and Badminton Competition on 23.02.2021, Recreational Games on 17.02.2021 and Run for Fit on 13.08.2021. Besides these, our students participated in Inter University Cricket Competition in MDU and National Handball Championship in Bareilly, UP in March 2021.

Cultural Committee:-

Cultural Committee organized activities not only for entertainment but also for all round development. But because of the onset of Pandemic only Talent Search Program could be organized on 13.02.2021 in offline mode. Online Poster Making Competition on 11.11.2020 was organized by Chemistry department. Various competition organized by the college were online. Social science society organized a Seminar on 12.03.2021 to celebrate 75th year of Independence "Azadi Ka Amrit Mahotsav". Home science department organized mask decoration competition on 24.12.2020 and 13.2.2021 and "Rangoli competition" on 25.2.2021. Inter class Antakshree Competition was also organized on 11.2.2021.

Anti Tobacco Committee organized Poster making, slogan writing competitions and made the students aware about the bad effects of tobacco consumption and inspired to create tobacco free society.

Traffic interpretation Center organized Road Safety Awareness camp on 22.03.2021 and rally on 25.03.2021 to make people about Road safety rules.

Nature interpretation centre organized Tree plantation program on 05.08.2021 to make the campus lush green.

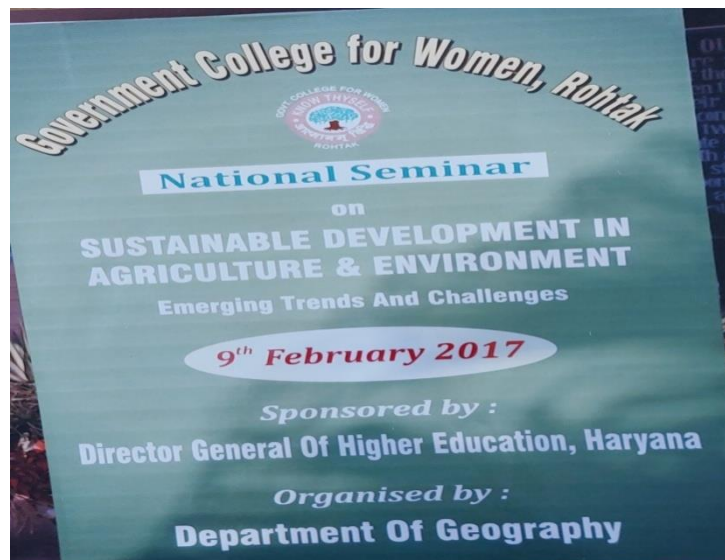
Passport Committee helped students to apply for Passport and 396 passports were issued in the session.

National seminar on “Sustainable Development in Agriculture and Environment”





National Seminar Geography Department

A national seminar was organised for faculty members, research scholars and post graduate students on "Sustainable Development in Agriculture and environment: Emerging trends and challenges" by department of Geography, Govt. P.G. College for Women, Rohtak on 9th Feb. 2017. 83 participants from various colleges participated in the seminar. Sustainable development in Agriculture and Environment: Emerging trends and Challenges

The related terms sustainable and sustainability are popularly used to describe a wide variety of activities which are generally ecologically laudable but which may not be sustainable. Basically, it is a dynamic concept in which development is related to conservation and optimum utilization of resources. It means maintaining ecological balance of our environment with development. The use of land, water, energy and food is being promoted as a conceptual tool for achieving sustainable pattern. The pressures on the natural resources have tremendously increased over years by man's greed for commercialization and livelihood of local people. Wide scale increase in population and tree felling depleted the natural resource to a level, which has posed a problem for the very sustenance of man. Therefore, it is imperative to understand the consequences of man made initiatives and to devise proper strategies to counteract these detrimental effects to keep a balance of the environment and development for going together as two wheels of cart. Environmental degradation including depletion of renewable and non renewable resource and pollution of air, water and soils can be significant source of stress upon societies. It can act as social integration indirectly, through the constraints that it puts on productive activities and it can also have more direct social impacts. The excess use of chemicals in agriculture has increased its extend very rapidly but this system of agriculture has created many health problems, reduction in soil productivity, contamination of agriculture in food products and water, decrease in yield and ultimately degradation of environment.

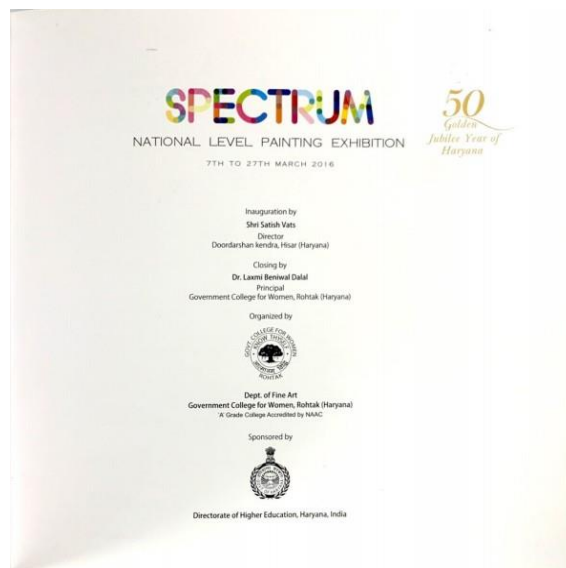
To achieve the target of sustainable development, a need for accounting the cost of environment and natural resource is deeply, needed which will further result in the

6. Population growth & environmental degradation

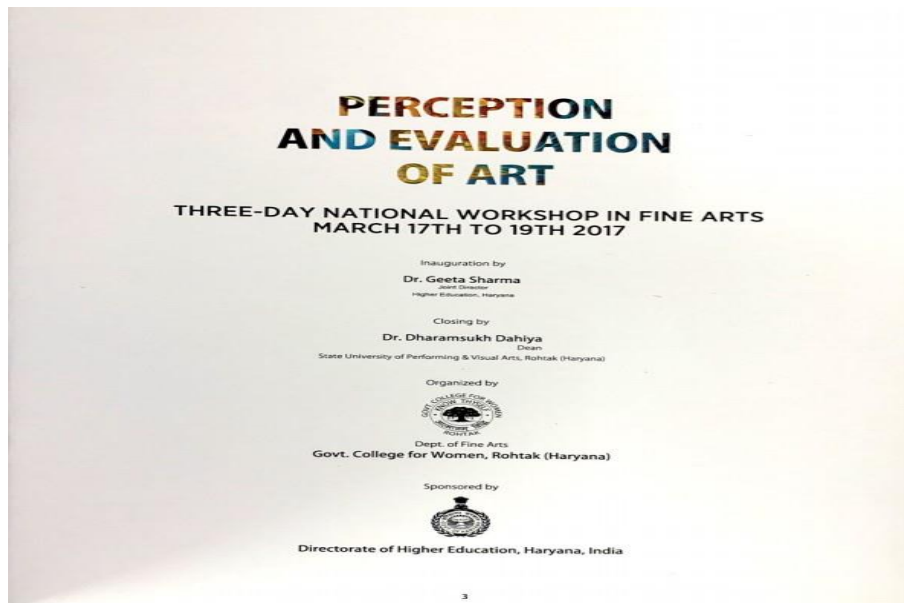

Swachh Bharat Summer Internship, 2018

Addressing the nation on 43rd edition of 'Mann Ki Baat' Prime Minister Narendra Modi announced the 'Government Special Summer Internship' linked to Swachh Bharat Abhiyan. Asked NSS Volunteers and other youngsters to join internship and contribute towards a 'Clean India'. Jointly designed by three ministries- Drinking Water and Sanitation, Human Resource Development and Youth Affairs and Sports- the 100 hours experiential internship program would require the candidate to visit one or more village and conduct activities of their choice to contribute to the cause of rural sanitation.

Village covered- MakrauliKhurd

Students of Govt. P.G. College for Women, Rohtak, selected for SBSI with their Nodal officer and their program officers went their selected villages. Firstly they met the Sarpanch who was already informed about SBSI program and the activities to be held in the village. After taking permission from Sarpanch, the volunteers started performing their duties in which Awareness Campaign was performed first in which various elements regarding 'Swachh Bharat Mission' were covered. Through the poetic recitation, speech delivery, poster makings, the volunteers guided the villagers about the schemes launched by the government for improving the condition of rural sanitation; various examples were given to spread awareness and message of Swachh Bharat Mission.

NukkadNatak was performed in this internship activity. The Nukkad Natak was based on cleanliness and awareness about rural sanitation. It was performed in the local language. It was one of the reason through which the villagers enjoyed the most and understood the real meaning of the play. Then folk song were used to aware the villagers more about 'Swachh Bharat Mission'. Songs were performed at various places as in different streets in the whole villages and almost 12 hours were spent in this activity.

















Then the volunteers were divided into different groups for door to door survey. In which a questionnaire was made consisting of questions related to water, garbage, dumping waste, ground water and hygiene. The volunteers personally went to cover each house to interact and to create a firm bond between both the sides. The survey was not only to get information but it was considered as the most useful part of 'Swachh Bharat Mission' because of the personal interaction. The volunteers told about various things related to the mission and listened to their issues regarding rural sanitation and they gave them useful solutions in return. It motivated villagers to follow the guidance and tips given to them and contribute towards the mission. Nearby 20 hours were spent in this procedure.







Movie screening was organized in the villages. It was another motivating step towards rural sanitation as large number of villagers as well as school children were gathered for the screening of Toilet EkPrem Katha' and various other clips were shown on 'Swachh Bharat and Rural Sanitation', Importance of Toilets were the main highlight of the programme. Almost 4 hours were spent in these activities.

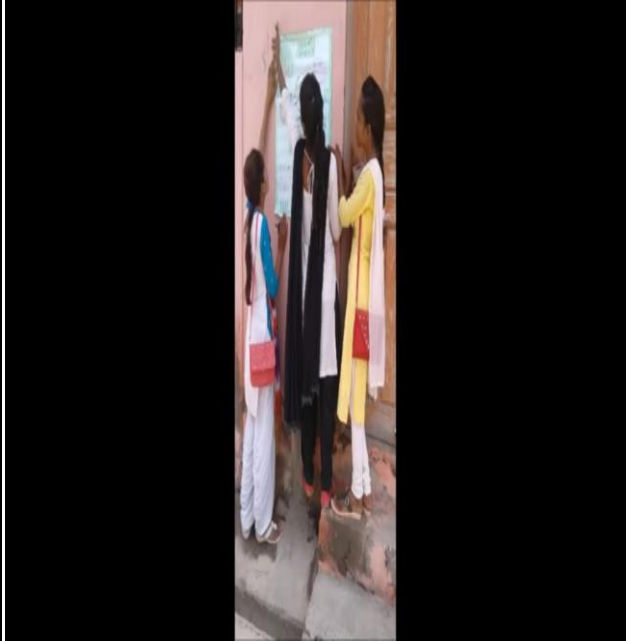
Later on, volunteers actively participated in making the villages neat and clean by contributing towards rural sanitation through street cleaning, drain cleanings and cleaning of back alleys. Their enthusiasm was appreciated by the villagers and it also inspired others to contribute towards "Swachh Bharat Mission". Children and villagers also joined to make the villages clean. Nearly 10 hours were spent in cleaning the whole villages.

SwachhtaMela and wall painting activities were performed in next procedure where for SwachhtaMela whole village & School children's were gathered in their particular Primary/Secondary/High School. In SwachhtaMela, Interaction between volunteers and villagers were the main highlight. They were guided about use of dustbin, importance of Toilets, various tips and steps to be taken for cleanliness and to keep themselves healthy and fit. What to do and what not to do it was made clear through showings same video clips and through verbally telling. The volunteers listed the problems they face and gave suitable solutions in return and also cleared their query regarding sanitation. Almost 10 hours were spent in this activity.

On the public walls in throughout the villages, various wall paintings were made by the volunteers to spread the message for Clean India. It was quite an impressive way to attract the attention of the villagers. Various paintings for differentiating the garbage while dumping and different slogans were written to spread awareness. Almost 8 hours were spent in this activity.

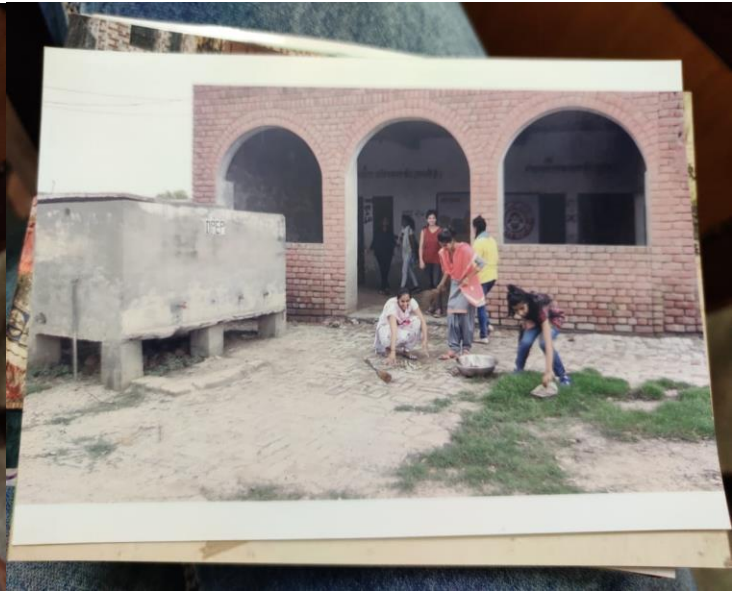
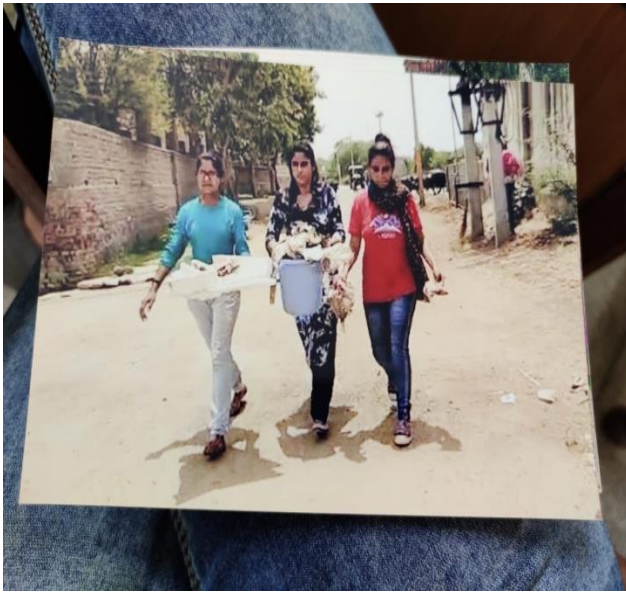
Next activity performed by the volunteers, was 'Waste Collection Drives' and 'Segregation of Solid Waste'. In waste collection drive, the villagers were guided to waste management to transfer the solid waste from the point of use and disposal to the point of landfill and different method to reuse the waste material. Different use of newspaper plastic, bottles were shown through video clipping. Nearly 3 hours were spent in this activity. For Segregation of solid waste, villagers were guided about the separation of waste into different elements. The garbage is divided into two parts wet and dry and into biodegradable or non-biodegradable waste. What to add and what not to while separating waste was made clear and live example were shown by the volunteers and almost 3 hours were spent in this program

In extra activity, the volunteers planted trees in the villages to taking ceremony was also held where the villagers took pledge to plant more trees and to use toilets and also to keep their villages clean and contribute towards the Rural sanitation. Their signature taken on papers participating in this cause in future. Nearly 10 hours were spent in this activity.

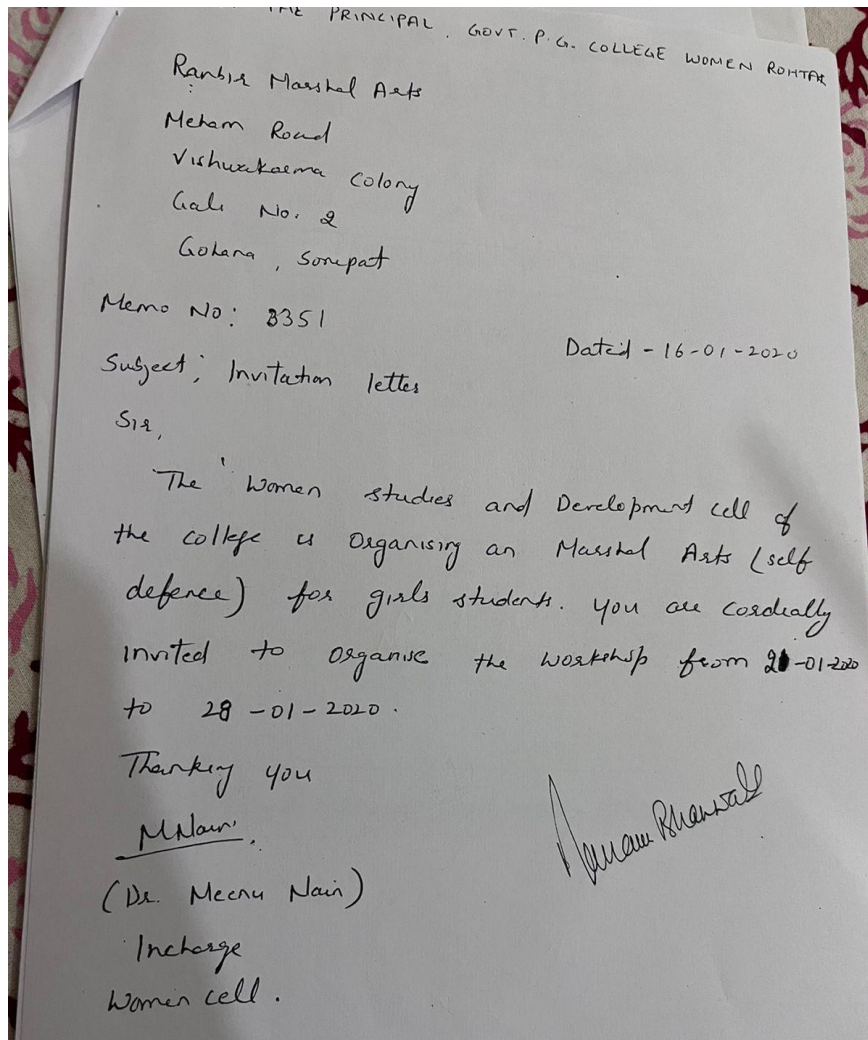

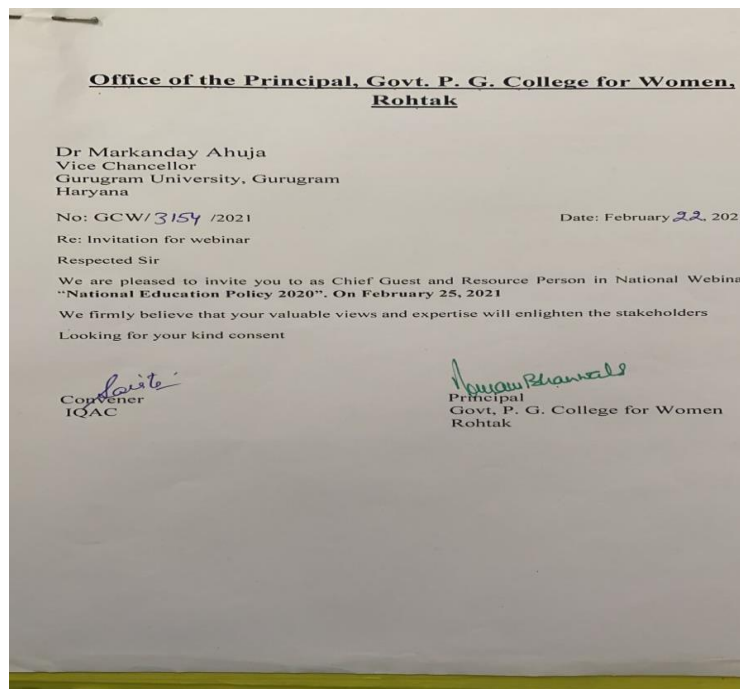

Chief Guest and Keynote speaker, Obstetrics and Gynaecologist, Rohtak, and Former President Inner Wheel Club, Rohtak, on National Webinar on "Polycystic Ovarian Disease (PCOD) and Women Health During COVID" explained in detail that "Polycystic ovary syndrome (PCOS) is a hormonal disorder common among women of reproductive age. Women with PCOS may have infrequent or prolonged menstrual periods or excess male hormone (androgen) levels. The ovaries may develop numerous small collections of fluid (follicles) and fail to regularly release eggs. 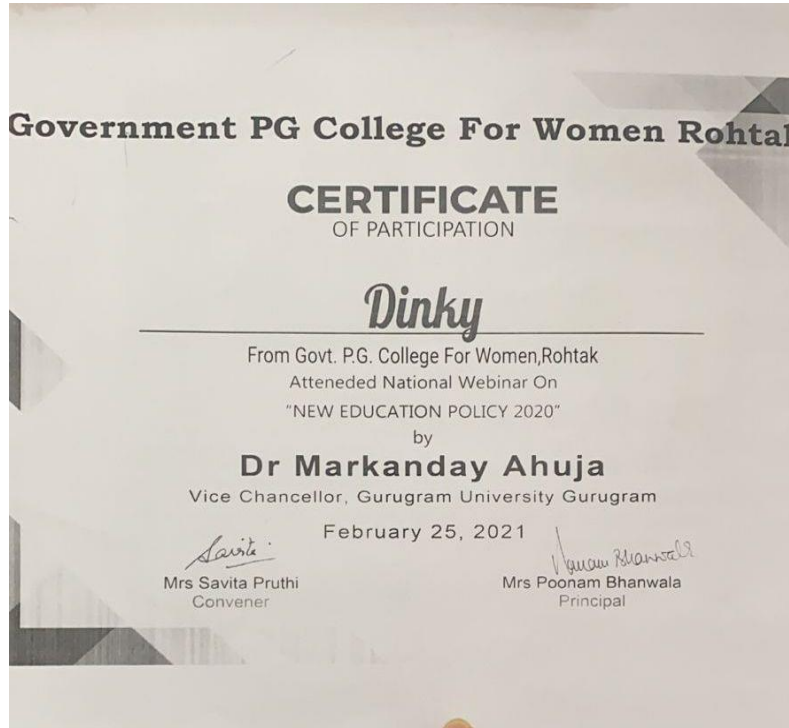

Aims of the Seminar
